REMINDER: Honor Roll, Conduct and Tardiness

As stated in our Parent-Student Handbook, a student must receive an A (excellent) or B (good) in conduct to be eligible for honors. A student who does not receive an A or B in Conduct will not receive First or Second Honors even though grades might warrant it. Moreover, a student with excessive tardiness or excessive unexcused absences will not receive First or Second Honors. School begins at 8:00 a.m. with morning prayers, and arrival at any time after that is considered late. The exception to this policy is when tardiness occurs as a result of bus transportation. If you choose not to use bus transportation, it is imperative that your children arrive before 8:00 a.m. each day to receive any honors recognition.
