

MAP Assessments

Over the next few weeks all of our students will participate in the **MAP** (Measure of Academic Progress) **Assessment**. This assessment will help teachers and administrators improve learning for all students and make informed decisions to promote a student's academic growth. **MAP** is a computer adaptive test, which means every student gets a unique set of test questions based on responses to previous questions. As the student answers correctly, questions may get harder; if the student answers incorrectly, the questions may get easier. The results assist teachers because they identify a student's strengths and weaknesses. Teachers can use this information to help guide instruction in the classroom. This is not a timed test. Students are encouraged just to do their best and see how far they can go.
