IMPORTANT NOTICE

We have a strong volunteer community at SDSC and we love that so many take an active role in the daily lives of our students! When you are in the school building, it is important to NEVER open the school doors for any other adult wishing to enter the building – even for other parents/volunteers – unless directed/authorized by a member of the school staff. For the safety of everyone, the staff/administration must always be aware of - and authorize - the adults who enter the school building. <u>This includes admitting other parents into the building who are waiting for dismissal of their children at the end of the school day</u>. This policy has been made on the advice of the New York State Police and is for the safety of all those who are in the school building. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
